BSI Timeline

Teacher Nominations Open Early December

Teachers can begin nominating students for BSI classes starting in early December.

Students Accept Nomination December/January

Once teachers have completed a nomination, students/parents will receive an email notification allowing them to accept the nomination and begin their application.

Student Applications Due Early February

After accepting their nomination, students will need to provide all of their application materials by the due date: a short essay, informal transcript, and a teacher recommendation (can be from the nominating teacher). Teacher nominations will also have to be complete by the deadline.

Notification of Acceptance Mid-February

Belin-Blank staff will review all completed applications and notify students of their applications status: accepted, alternate, or declined.

Final Preparations

Students pay remaining program costs and prepare for their weeklong learning adventure.

Program Begins June

Students will move into their dorms. meet their classmates and instructors. and take an interactive deep dive into their class topics.

BSI

Along with their similarly-minded peers, students will learn from expert instructors, attend field trips, hear from guest speakers, and engage in fun evening activities.

Program Ends

At the closing event, students have an opportunity to showcase their learning to peers and family members before departing home with memories that will last a lifetime.
