

Overall Course Outcomes

High school IOAPA students earned an average score of 85.7 across all IOAPA courses, demonstrating above-average performance in college-level courses.



In 2020-2021, IOAPA offered 15 college-level courses to high school students who would not otherwise have access to them.

Passing Rate

Percentage of students who passed the course (received a C- or better) out of those who completed it.

On-schedule rate

Amount of overdue work relative to the amount of work due. This can indicate a course's pacing.


Completion Rate

Percentage of students who completed the course out of all those who started it.

Quality of work

How well the students did on the work they completed.

Computer Science Courses

Students taking these courses should have some coding experience and be comfortable with project-based learning.

AP Computer Science A

15 students enrolled in this course for 2020-21 These students had a 100% completion rate.

AP Computer Science Principles

14 students completed this course, for a 93% completion rate.
